

 - Temporary access through Fulton entrance from Larkin plaza
- Main's upper floors and the Mix at Main scheduled to open in June
 - Conditional upon elevator work
 - SFPL To Go ceases operations at the Main
 - Fewer restrictions in place
 - Access to reference collections and more computers



Daily Number of Visitors Since Opening




SFPL has welcomed over 308,000 patrons back through SFPL to Go service. Daily average of visitors from April 11 to May 10 was 1,482.
